



The General Gumala Foundation 5 Year Review

The Gumala Trust Board wishes to advise Beneficiaries of the General Gumala Foundation ("GIPL") and Members of Gumala Aboriginal Corporation ("GAC") that the fourth 5-Year Review of the Foundation and Trust Deed is underway. Over 20 meeting locations have been scheduled across the state with the intention of seeking the maximum amount of feedback on the operations of the Foundation, including both GAC and GIPL, and the Trust Deed that governs the Foundation.

At each location consultations with the Banyjima, Innawonga and Nyiyaparli Traditional Owners will be conducted by representatives of GIPL followed by the independent review team led by Mr Rick Brooks. All Beneficiaries who attend the Review meetings will be entitled to receive a payment of \$250. Due to the Review travelling to the numerous regions, there will not be any travel payments available. We will endeavour to make payments for attendance in 14 days.

The outcome of the Review will include the results and recommendations for improvements for the areas within the terms of reference. Please note that the Foundation Review does not cover the Yandi Land Use Agreement ("YLUA"), which itself is subject to a separate 5-year review being run by GAC and Rio Tinto. Members should take the opportunity to put forward their comments and questions for the YLUA Review at the GAC Consultation Meeting to be held prior to the GAC Annual General Meeting on Saturday 20th October 2018.
