



Traditional Owner Director GIPL

Gumala Aboriginal Corporation (GAC), the Shareholder of Gumala Investment Pty Ltd (GIPL), which acts as the Trustee of the General Gumala Foundation, requires three Traditional Owner Directors for appointment to the GIPL Board.

The objects of the Trust are the relief of poverty, sickness, suffering, distress, misfortune, or destitution of the Traditional Owners residing in the Pilbara region of Western Australia.

To be eligible to apply, you must be a:

- A recognised Traditional Owner of Innawonga, Banyjima or Nyiyaparli; and
- Not a director of GAC; and
- Not involved in the day to day operations of GAC.

Please note that this is a demanding and vitally important role and as such requires committed and diligent applicants due to the nature of the Trust. A desirable applicant would possess one or more of the following:

- A professional qualification in either Law, Finance or Business Management related disciplines; and or
- Previous experience in or as a Director of a Corporation or Trustee of a Charitable Trust;

Applicants who meet only some of the above criteria are nevertheless encouraged to apply and should provide three referees from well-regarded individuals or organisations, at least one of whom is Indigenous.

Successful applicants are required to undergo the relevant police checks to ensure that they have not previously been bankrupt or subject to any fraud and other related civil and criminal proceedings. The existence of a criminal record does not make an applicant ineligible.
